Occasion was an evening of classical music organized by SPIC MACAY society under the SPIC MACAY Jaipur chapter.

The performing artists were **SHRI RITESH AND RAJNEESH MISHRA**, sons of the living legends Pt. Rajan Mishra and Pt. Sajan Mishra.
